The Campton Area Resource Center was born and incorporated as a NH non profit in May 2008.

Members of the community recognized the need for a source where residents could turn to for basic necessities.

CARC has gone on to establish as a 501c3 organization that is recognized by the federal government as a nonprofit entity and public charity. All contributions to CARC are tax deductible under the law.

Today, the involvement of our staff, volunteers, and local businesses enable us to meet more of our neighbors' needs each day.



THE STORE

In our store, we sell donated household items, furniture, and clothing for men, women and children....all at reasonably low prices.

All the items are donated from giving neighbors. All items are thoroughly gone through and organized to make a pleasant shopping experience for all.

All the funds made from the thrift store, enable CARC to operate a food pantry.....

THE PANTRY

The food pantry feeds over 200 people a month, and is a great help to many of our area residents, who would otherwise go without.



THE HANCOCK FUND

This is an emergency assistance program that helps residents of Campton, Thornton, and Ellsworth who are experiencing an immediate financial crisis. This resource typically assists with utility bills, rent, medically related expenses, and transportation.
